Tuesday, October 11, 2022	Open House at George H. Moody MS (Session 1: 4:30-5:30 p.m. - Session 2: 6:00-7:00 p.m.)
Wednesday, October 12, 2022	Open House at Tuckahoe MS (Session 1: 4:30-6:00 p.m.)
Thursday, October 20, 2022	Deadline for receipt of MYP applications (public school students submit to your school counselor; private school applicants submit to IB Office at Tuckahoe MS)

Continue IB in High School at Henrico HS or J.R. Tucker HS

- Complete the IBMYP in grades 9-10 by taking a full load of IB classes each year
- Design and implement your IBMYP Personal Project
- Transition easily into the IB Diploma Program or the IB Career-related Program for grades 11-12 (full IB course load)
- Research and craft your IBDP Extended Essay or IBCP Reflective Project
- Earn IB recognition from top universities locally or around the world, enter the workforce with an industry certification, or both!

Attend Neighborhood High School

- Explore your interests by taking a variety of courses
- Choose from honors, AP, or college prep courses
- Option to attend the ACE center programs with the opportunity to earn an industry certification
- Prepare for college, workforce, or military

Attend an HCPS Specialty Center

- Take specialized courses for your center's focus as well as other college prep, honors, or AP courses within the school community
